

Postmortem Submission Process



- Please fill two gray top tubes (sodium fluoride/ potassium oxalate) with 10mL Postmortem blood
- Minimum Requirements for PM panels is 4mL (enough to run 1 screen and 2 confirmation tests)



- Place all specimens (vial sleeve, urine, tissue container) inside front pocket of specimen bag



- Red top tube does not contain any perservatives
- Can be used for vitreous, gastric, or bile fluids
- **Note: Red vials are not included in PM Collection kits**



- Insert completed Chain of Custody form into back pocket of specimen bag

- Place tubes into protective sleeve for shipment



- Place specimen bag in box, add seal to outside and initial.






- Up to 40mL of urine can be put in this container.
- Can be used for tissue submissions as well.
- Do not exceed more the 40mL or 30g of sample

- Only one airbill to be used and placed on outside of bag
- Each FedEx bag must have it's own airbill attached
